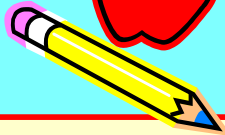
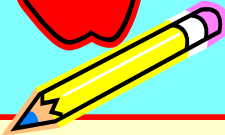

Target Skills This Week!

Math – Understanding subtraction stories. Finding the “unknown” part in a story problem. Continue building number sentences and number bonds.

Writing – Narrative writing – Writing about our experiences – Explanatory Writing – Telling “how” to do something. Learning how to “build” stories.
