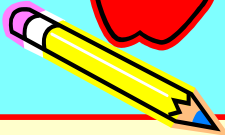
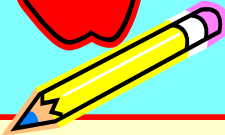

## Target Skills This Week!

**Math** – Practicing new addition/subtraction strategies. Comparing lengths of objects. Order 3 lengths by comparing objects. Measure length using standard/nonstandard tools.

**Writing** – Personal Narrative Writing - sharing info/experiences about our own lives. Informational Writing – Sharing facts/info with our audience.

**Reading** – Reading Groups – Discuss who is telling the story in a given text.

**Phonics** – VC/CV pattern – (see below)

**Write a report about your favorite person. Share several FACTS to help us learn about them. Where were they born. Where did they go to school? Where do they live now? What is their job? What do they like to do?**

**Make a list of things that are BLUE! Practice building words that you don't know slowly and carefully. Listen for chunks that you do know.**

### Phonics Rule Of the Week

Rule: When working on multi-syllable words finger spell one syllable at a time. Remember - A vowel in a closed syllable is usually short.

contest, tablet, magnet,
