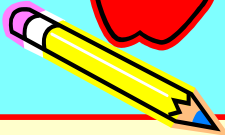
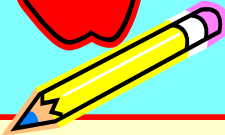

Target Skills This Week!

Math – Tens and Ones - Adding 10s and 1s to a two digit number. Problem solving (varied problem types) within 20.

Writing – Informational Writing – Sharing facts with others in our writing. Opinion Writing – State your opinion and support it with details.

Reading – Reading Groups – Reading grade-level texts with purpose and understanding. Focus on comprehension strategies.

Writing Ideas

Write a story about your earliest memory. What happened? How old were you? Who was with you? How have you changed since you were that little?

Make a list of your favorite toys. Focus on spelling bigger words one chunk at a time. Listen for chunks that you know. Listen for long and short vowel sounds.

Phonics Rule Of the Week

Bossy r – When a vowel is followed by an r the vowel could make a different sound than it usually does. (ar, er, ir, or, ur)
Most of the time 'or' says /or/ like in the word corn.
