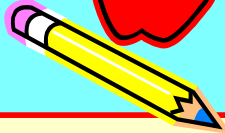

Target Skills This Week!

Math – Continue talking about 2D and 3D shapes. Identify coins (penny, nickel, dime, quarter) and tell their value. Counting small groups of coins.

Phonics Rule Of the Week

1-1-1 doubling rule – If a word has 1 syllable, and 1 short vowel that ends in 1 consonant – You should double the last letter before adding a suffix that starts with a vowel. (suffixes – ing, ed, er, est, y)

run, runner – big, biggest – split, splitting, - slip, slipped – sun, sunny – flip, flipping
